We are now in official “hurricane season” until Nov. 30th. To help everyone stay as safe as possible, we have created this hurricane booklet for your information. Every storm is different and everyone has their own unique home situation. Please use this booklet as a guide, but know that you may need to make additional plans or modifications to meet your unique needs.

In this booklet you will find specific information about how we can help and resources and information you can use to tailor your own emergency plan. It is important for every family, including families of one, to plan what they will do BEFORE a storm is upon us. The included pages, phone numbers and online links can help give you information, but YOU have to make the plan.

Because of COVID 19, we have had to modify our respite care plan. For 2020, Ft. King Presbyterian will offer respite space in our Sunday school classrooms for congregants without power who need a place to cool off. We only have 5 classrooms, so can only accommodate 5 family groups, first come, first served. Our hours will be Monday-Friday from 9-5. Please plan to bring ready made food that does not need cooking or warming. A bathroom is available and we ask everyone to wipe it down after use. Please plan to bring your own games, reading materials, etc. to pass the time, as we will not be able to share resources.
